

### > himalayan pink salt



During the Secondary Age, when an Ocean's portion had been captured underground, a lot quantity of salt settled on earth in different layers in order to create big thickness. The region where appeared the most concentration of salt is Himalaya one, where salt had been in contact with magma fluids coming up from the deepest strata and giving it its pink colour because of iron traces. Himalaya salt comes to us in its original pureness, it is not refined and it has not any environmental contamination. It preserves its natural richness and its anti-oxidant characteristic; it is extracted by hand hard work and then washed in pure spring water and dried at sun. with great patience is finally stoned - grinded. It could be employed in cosmetics too; rubbing its crystals directly on skin it produce a peeling effect, erasing ancient cellars and helping circulation; melting in water drives internal fluids onto exterior.
